ELECTRICITY AND WATER TARIFF (EFFECTIVE 1st MARCH 2016)

The electricity and water tariff will be adjusted for other accounts while retaining the current tariff in application prior to the coming into force of the adjustment resolution for each Bahrain customer holding one domestic account only.

The basis for retaining the tariff in application prior to the enforcement of the Adjustment Resolution for a Bahraini customer holding a single domestic account:

The domestic consumption for a Bahraini citizen holding a single account only:

- A Bahraini head of a household*.
- A single domestic consumption category account
- The address in the Identity Card (ID) must correspond to that registered for the electricity and water account.

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Essentiality for the Account Address to Correspond to the Smart Card Address

- One domestic account for each Bahraini citizen will be automatically entered in the Customers' Services System for retaining the current electricity and water tariff where the address in the Identity Card correspond to that registered for the electricity and water account.
- 2. If the ID address does not correspond to that of the electricity and water account, or if a customer holding more than one account wishes to retain the current tariff for a particular account, such customer has to contact the Information and eGovernment Authority to have his electricity and water address changed.

The Address Registered for Electricity & Water Account Retention of Current Tariff for a Bahraini Citizen Holding a Single Account

*The Situations to which the current tariff will continue applicable for a Bahraini citizen holding a single domestic account:

- A Bahraini head of household (married/divorcee/widower/single) whose identity card address corresponds to the account registered for the electricity and water account (a customer holding more than one account will be eligible for one domestic account only at his choice, provided that the personal address of such customer in the identity card corresponds to the selected address registered for the electricity and water account).
- For other wives with an address different from the husband's address, provided that the account is registered in the her name.
- 3. A Bahraini female customer who is married to a non-Bahraini where the electricity and water account is registered in her name.
- 4. The Bahraini minors who have guardians or the Bahraini minors who have no guardian with the approval written of the Minors' Estate Directorate.
